Clubhouse Dress Code

It is expected that Members will choose to dress appropriately befitting the surroundings and atmosphere of the Clubhouse and will advise their guests accordingly. Exceptions may also be made for certain special events. The club dress code is as follows:

Proper Men's Attire:

- All shirts must have a collar (traditional or mock), and must be tucked in at all times unless so designed to be worn untucked.
- Hats are permitted on the lower level of the clubhouse and are to be worn forward at all times.

Proper Women's Attire:

- Dresses, blouses, or sweaters (including collarless and/or sleeveless) are acceptable in the clubhouse, shirts must be tucked in if so designed.
- Appropriate dress for women shall include dresses, slacks, skirts and shorts.

Applicable to both Men and Women:

• Dress denim is permissible in the clubhouse provided it is not torn, faded, or frayed.

The following attire is not acceptable in the clubhouse o<mark>r on t</mark>he golf course/practice facilities:

- Tee shirts, sweatshirts, tank tops, halter tops, spandex clothing or gym clothing.
- No blue jeans on golf course or practice facilities
- Ripped, soiled, stained, frayed, cut off, bare midriff or see through garments.
- No sweats, work-out, spandex, or gym attire in the upstairs clubhouse, golf course or practice areas.
- No pool attire; except in pool area.
- Footwear is required in the clubhouse on the golf course and practice areas.

Golf Course Dress Code

The guiding rule is Men and Women should wear clothing made for and designed for golf. The following types of clothing are prohibited on the golf course: denim of any kind, cutoffs, tennis shorts, cargo shorts, running shorts, tee-shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts and warm-up suits. If you are in doubt concerning your attire, please check with the golf shop.

Please Remember:

- Men's Shirts are required to have a collar or mock and must be tucked in on the golf course and range.
- Hats must always be worn forward on golf course or range and are not permitted on the upper level of the clubhouse.

Cell Phone Use

Out of respect for Members and their guests, management reserves the right to ask a member to turn off their mobile device should it interfere with the other members enjoyment of the club.

Liability

Members and guests shall use Club facilities at their own risk and shall assume sole responsibility for personal injury, personal property, and property damage. The Owner, its affiliates, officers, employees, representatives, and agents shall not be held liable for personal injury to any person while on Club premises, nor for loss or damage to personal property, brought onto, used, or stored on Club property, whether in lockers or elsewhere.

<u>Smoking</u>

Smoking is not permitted in any of the indoor facilities, the upper terrace, or the pool area. Smoking is permitted on the lower golf patio and in tennis court seating areas.

Gate Access

Your host will have notified Club Staff who will have communicated your name to the Gate access personnel. Please use the guest access lane when entering the Wynstone community. Practice facilities and lockers are available for golf guests. The Locker room attendant will show you to your locker. The Golf shop staff will direct you to our practice facility.
